



Indian Grass - *Sorghastrum nutans*

- Height: 5-6 feet - Width: 2-3 feet - Native to Kansas, Missouri, Nebraska, & Iowa
- Growth: Upright Clump Grass - Fibrous Roots
- Ideal Growing Conditions: Full to Partial Sun in Medium to Dry Soils
- Flowers: August, September, & October - Color: Greenish Blue to Straw
- Wildlife Benefit: Seed, Cover, & Larval Host for Skippers
- Partner Plants: Many varieties of Milkweed, Native Grasses, & Wildflowers



Little Bluestem - *Schizachyrium scoparium*

- Height: 2-3 feet - Width: 1-2 feet - Native to Kansas, Missouri, Nebraska, & Iowa
- Growth: Upright Clump Grass - Fibrous Roots
- Ideal Growing Conditions: Full to Partial Sun in Medium to Dry Soils
- Flowers: August, September, & October - Color: Greenish Blue to Copper
- Wildlife Benefit: Seed, Cover, & Larval Host for Skippers
- Partner Plants: Many varieties of Milkweed, Native Grasses, & Wildflowers



Prairie Dropseed - *Sporobolus heterolepis*

- Height: 2-3 feet - Width: 2 feet - Native to Kansas, Missouri, Nebraska, & Iowa
- Growth: Upright Clump Grass - Fibrous Roots
- Ideal Growing Conditions: Full to Partial Sun to Shade in Medium to Dry Soils
- Flowers: August, September, & October - Color: Green to Golden Brown
- Wildlife Benefit: Seed, Cover, & Larval Host for Skippers
- Partner Plants: Many varieties of Milkweed, Native Grasses, & Wildflowers

- Flowers: August, September, & October - Color: Green to Golden Brown
- Wildlife Benefit: Seed, Cover, & Larval Host for Skippers
- Partner Plants: Many varieties of Milkweed, Native Grasses, & Wildflowers
